<b>Title</b>	<b>English instructor</b>
<b>Responsability</b>	You will find yourself working within the Service Enseignement, under the supervision of Sébastien Delanoë and the coordination of Ivan Rouault.
<b>Missions and actions</b>	Teach English in the primary schools, take an active part in the extracurricular life and help promote the English language..
<b>Mission</b>	<b>Teaching English</b>
<b>action</b>	You are in charge of the English teaching from preschoolers to 5th graders, being in class for 12 hours a week average.
<b>action</b>	Alone in class with the children, you are in charge of discipline, the actual teaching content, the evaluating of the students in close relation with the Education Nationale, the coordinator and the referring main teachers.
<b>Mission</b>	<b>Participate to the extracurricular life for about 10 hours a week</b>
<b>action</b>	Create and lead challenging, engaging, educative and fun activities, related to the English language at lunchtime.
<b>action</b>	Supervise and accompany the children while they take their lunch at the cafeteria and do their homework at after school care.
<b>Mission</b>	<b>Help promote the English language</b>
<b>action</b>	Tutor high school students who wish to enroll in a year at the University of Kentucky, in helping them take on the TOEFL exam.
<b>action</b>	Run a workshop of conversation and expression in English for adults. Feed a blog with news of your life in France, follow up with partners in the US
<b>Obligations</b>	You are expected to work approximately between 25 and 30 hours a week at the beginning (preparation time included). You will have to spend entire days amongst children. Transportation from and to the US, as well as all visa costs remain at your responsibility.
<b>Advantages</b>	The city of Deauville will provide a house with utilities (including an internet connexion), and a stick-shift car to be shared with 2 other interns. Lunch meals can be taken at the school cafeteria. You will be covered by the French National Health Insurance. You will also benefit from the school official holidays.
<b>Salary</b>	Approximately 730 euros after tax per month
<b>Profile</b>	Focusing your work on the "well-being" of the children, you have a patient, educationalist and well organised nature. You adjust well to living abroad and have a high sense of responsibilities, regarding the care of children, and making sure projects are carried through. Past experience with children would be helpful. An English native speaker, you can also drive a stick-shift car.
