

## **Carol Ann Baily, Ed. D.**

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**Aventures en France** – Dr. Baily offers private and small group classes using the Lozanov Method to emphasize conversational French for travel. Students listen to prepared audio files of conversational dialogues in the text provided. In class, we activate the phrases, sentences, and verb forms needed for the necessary conversational topics. Beginners can acquire the basics of the French language with this method. Intermediate students can add to their vocabulary and grammatical knowledge. More advanced students can review the French they know and add to their conversational skills, often not emphasized in traditional classrooms.

Current classes are offered on Zoom for individuals or small groups of four or fewer. Students have the audio files and text to listen to each day. Classes use the text as the basis for the conversations among the students or between the students and the teacher. Classes are offered in sets of 10 2-hour classes. These classes are scheduled with the students and teacher so it may take 12 weeks or more to work in the 10 classes. The cost of the 20 hours of class include the text and audio files used in the classes.
